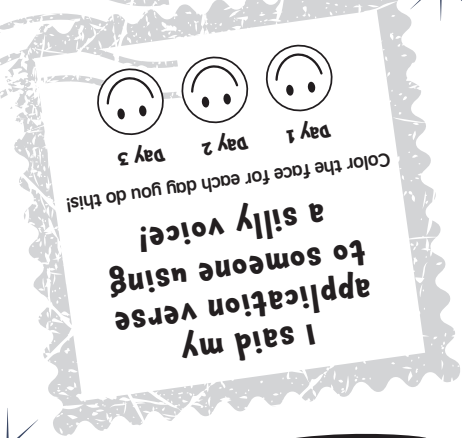

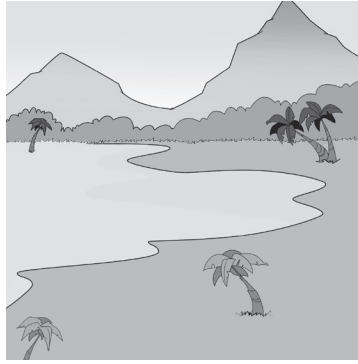
BIBLE BASICS:

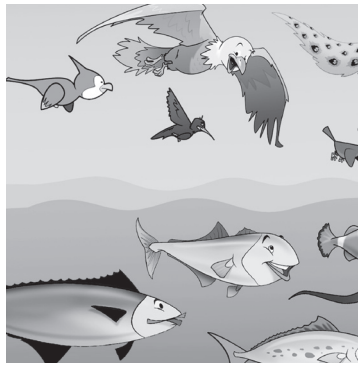

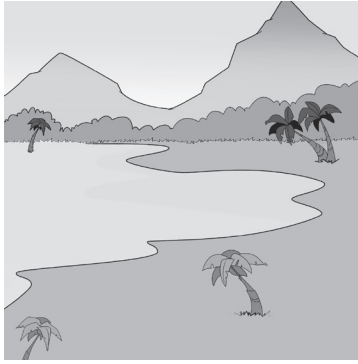

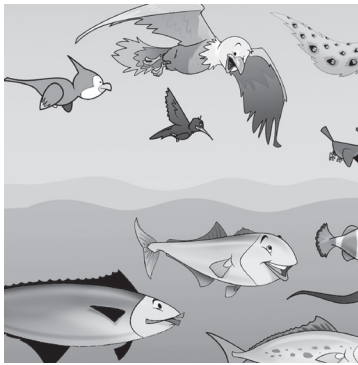
